7. Describe your Future Plans for Uptake Research Results (1 slide)

6. Early outcomes that have been accomplished (1 slide)
7. Lessons that you have learnt so far and can share with other fellows - what has worked and what hasn't? (1 slide)
8. Strategies to continue influencing policy before the end of your project (1 slide)
